Dear friends of Saint Jude, Dear pilgrims of the heart,

🖿 n June 29th 2007, Benedict XVI announced the creation of a *Jubilee Year devoted to Saint Paul on* the occasion of the two thousandth anniversary of his birth. Together with this Apostle of fire we will move forth during this novena. Inspired by his words, we will discover how, day by day, he "experienced" Christ in his life, despite the risks, the difficulties and the persecutions. Through his teaching, we will let ourselves be changed so that we, like him, can declare: "Neither death nor life – he wrote to the Romans – nor angels, nor principalities, nothing already in existence and nothing still to come, nor any power, nor the heights nor the depths, nor any created thing whatever, will be able to come between us and the love of God, known to us in Christ Jesus our Lord." (Rm 8, 38-39).

FIRST DAY: FRIDAY, MARCH 27TH

"You have surely heard how I lived in the past, within Judaism, and how there was simply no limit to the way I persecuted the Church of God in my attempts to destroy it;" (Galatians I, 13),

Forgive me, Lord, for having "persecuted" You by my many sins. I beseech you infinite mercy. Amen.

SECOND DAY: SATURDAY, MARCH 28th

"But God, being rich in faithful love, through the great love with which he loved us, even when we were dead in our sins, brought us to life with Christ - it is through grace that you have been saved and raised us up with him and gave us a place with him in heaven, in Christ Jesus." (Ephesians 2, 4-6),

Lord, thank you for forgiving my trespasses and to call upon me to be a witness to your mercy surrounding me. Amen.

THIRD DAY: SUNDAY, MARCH 29TH

"After all, brothers, you were called to be free; do not use your freedom as an opening for self-indulgence, but be servants to one another in love, since the whole of the Law is summarised in the one commandment: You must love your neighbour as yourself." (Galatians 5,13-14),

Lord, teach me to see you in my brothers and sisters so that I may share of Your love. Amen.

FOURTH DAY: MONDAY, MARCH 30[™]

"This, then, is what I pray, kneeling before the Father, from whom every fatherhood, in heaven or on earth, takes its name. In the abundance of his glory may he, through his Spirit, enable you to grow firm in power with regard to your inner self, so that Christ may live in your hearts through faith, and then, planted in love and built on love." (Ephesaens 3,14-17),

Lord, thank You for revealing yourself to us as Father, through Jesus, your Son and in the Spirit so that we may love as You love us. Amen.

FIFTH DAY: TUESDAY, MARCH 31st

"For it is not against human enemies that we have to struggle, but against the principalities and the ruling forces who are masters of the darkness in this world, the spirits of evil in the heavens. That is why you must take up all God's armour, or you will not be able to put up any resistance on the evil day, or stand your ground even though you exert yourselves to the full." (Ephesians 6,12-13),

Lord, may Your grace help us to remain faithful to the sacraments of life, left to us by Your Son, as well as to prayer. Amen.

SIXTH DAY: WEDNESDAY, APRIL 1ST

"I have learnt to manage with whatever I have.I know how to live modestly, and I know how to live luxuriously too: in every way now I have mastered the secret of all conditions: full stomach and empty stomach, plenty and poverty There is nothing I cannot do in the One who strengthens me." (Philippians 4, 11b-13),

Lord, thank you for your Providence towards me, in the difficult times as well as in the moments of joy. You are truly our Father. Amen.

SEVENTH DAY: THURSDAY, APRIL 2ND

"It is on account of this that I have to put up with suffering, even to being chained like a criminal. But God's message cannot be chained up. So I persevere for the sake of those who are chosen, so that they, too, may obtain the salvation that is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory." (2 Timothy 2, 9-10),

Lord, give me the strength to bear the ordeals that I encounter on my way. May your Word and your Sacraments always comfort me. Amen.

EIGHTH DAY: FRIDAY, APRIL 3RD

"As for me, my life is already being poured away as a libation, and the time has come for me to depart. I have fought the good fight to the end; I have run the race to the finish; I have kept the faith." (2 Timothy 4,6-7),

Lord, thank You for giving me the perseverance in the tribulations so that I may remain faithful to Your Word and to Your Love. Amen.

NINTH DAY: SATURDAY, APRIL 4TH

"But as for me, it is out of the question that I should boast at all, except of the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world." (Galatians 6, 14),

Lord, help me bear my cross to the end, like Yourself and Saint Paul, so that I may be with You, one day, in Your Kingdom. Amen.
